Those who want to support students' social change projects, enrich their learning and ensure the Islander legacy continues.

Anyone can enter the Friends programme at one of three levels, these are:

- Friends, with a donation of \$1,000HKD
- Families, with a donation of \$5,000HKD and
- Classes or Groups that want to give in excess of \$20,000HKD.

Every donors' name will be added to the honour gallery. The honour gallery will be in the heart of the campus, on the large walls between the library and the entrance. It will acknowledge the generosity of the Islander community and what it means to be an Islander. It will reflect the different levels within the Friends programme. Class or Group donations are a little bit special. The 1972 year group (Class of 1974) were the first group to come together as a collective to make a Class donation. If a group (more than 2 people) decide that they would like to make a donation in excess of \$20,000 collectively they will be acknowledged with a unique donor gallery listing all their names. Plus they will be invited to exclusive campus events.

## Impact of Lifelong Friends

The impact of each donation will be significant and wide-ranging. The programme will support students' social change projects - projects that advocate for human rights or reduce campus waste or support people in need. These real world learning experiences require funding. There are many areas where a broader, more authentic and relevant education incurs costs. You will enrich students' education and help them to achieve their goals. Island School's deep connection to the community and to its partners enriches learning. Relationships with our neighbours, NGOs and partners are key. As we move forward we plan to maintain our current community partnerships, regenerate old ones and develop new alliances. Our new campus will be a hub for our community as we continue to play our role in the fabric of society, both locally and globally. A world class education requires world class resources and equipment. Island School encourages new ways of thinking,

seeing and being. Visiting experts inspire students to move out of their comfort zone and try new things. Well resourced classrooms, gyms and labs and the teaching that happens within them changes the course of people's lives. Becoming a Lifelong Friend of the School is an investment in education at a time when it is most needed.
